



**HOWDY all Campers, Parents & Chaperones!!!**

**I am thrilled that your child will be joining us for camp this year! This letter will help to keep you informed about things to bring and all other camp related information.**

**We will be staying at Camp COTUBIC in Bellefontaine, Ohio once again. Camp begins on Monday, July 26th and ends on Friday, July 30th. Check in on Monday will be between 11am and 1pm at the campgrounds. Once an entire cabin has checked in, lunch will be provided by the camp. Please check with your church leaders about transportation to and from Camp COTUBIC.**

**This years camp theme is: TRAIL BLAZERS and we will be learning about the path that Moses blazed for the Lord throughout his life. During the week of camp, we will be fishing, swimming, climbing the Rock Wall, going on the Blob, the 100 foot water slide, having a Ho-Down, playing messy games and much, much more! Trust me when I say, if they had fun last year, they are going to LOVE it this year!**

**The following information is important for all parents and chaperones: A special reminder for all kids: No electronics are permitted on this trip. If one is found, they will be confiscated immediately. This includes: Cell phones, Game Boys, Nintendo DS, CD Players, MP3 Players, iPods, etc. Please do not ask your child to call you from a cell phone or other device. We promise if there is an emergency, we will contact you immediately. Cameras are permitted, however, I do not recommend sending expensive cameras because we cannot guarantee their safe return. Also, please put your child's first & last name on all important things.**

**If your child takes medication, please pack it separately in its original containers in a ziplock baggie with your child's first & last name clearly printed on the outside. Inside the baggie should be clear instructions on how to dispense this medication to your child. Please hand these bagged meds to an adult traveling with your church group and they will hand them directly to the camp nurse upon arrival to Camp COTUBIC. On Friday, before departure, the meds will be passed back to your church leader to bring home to you.**

**Departure from the camp will be at noon on Friday, July 30th. If you are bringing your child to camp, please be sure to check them out at the Check Out station in front of the Mess Hall.**

**Kids Camp has been an overwhelming success on our district over the past few years and our numbers are growing. Please take into account when registering that once**

the campgrounds is full, we are no longer able to accept registrations. If you register after we have filled the camp, we will notify you by phone and mail your check back to you. All registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis so plan accordingly.

On this page is a list of our rules for the week. Please remind your child that everyone is to follow these instructions for their safety. Failure to do so will result in a call home and parents will be expected to come and pick up their child.

**CAMP RULES:**

- 1- Campers are expected to be respectful and obedient to all chaperones and adults in charge.
- 2- When an adult is talking, it is YOUR responsibility to be listening and NOT talking.
- 3- Christ-like attitudes and behavior are expected for the entire week.
- 4- All campers are expected to participate in all planned events.
- 5- No one is to be alone at any time. All campers must be accompanied by a chaperone.
- 6- Campers must respect each other and their belongings at all times.
- 7- Lights out at 11pm- NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 8- NO electronic devices of any kind are permitted on the campgrounds(Nintendo DS, Cell phones, iPods, MP3 Players, PSP, etc.)
- 9- No boys in girls cabins, no girls in boys cabins- for any reason.
- 10- Modest dress is required at all times.
- 11- This campus is CLOSED to all non-registered guests for the safety and security of our campers and team. No one is permitted to come or go without permission from Pastor Kim or Pastor Jenn.

**CONSEQUENCES:**

- 1- First Offense- Verbal Warning
- 2-Second Offense- Dean is notified and offender is required to pick up trash and clean the Mess Hall
- 3-Third Offense-A call home is made by one of the Directors or Deans and arrangements will be made for pick up from camp. Monies will not be refunded.
